





Curby the Blue Recycling Cart is 'screaming' for more recyclables! Color Curby **blue** and then use any **4 colors** to finish coloring the page.





Garbage Superheroes


Vultures are nature's garbage superheroes. They have super strong stomach acid that helps them eat and digest just about anything! They can eat dead things with diseases without getting sick!





Did you know...the word 'Mona' means 'My lady'? Color Glenda the Green Organics Cart posing as the famous Mona Lisa.




Coloring page - Inspired by Leonard Da Vinci's, Mona Lisa.

Compost is a crumbly, dark type of dirt rich in nutrients that is used as mulch or fertilizer to grow plants. Compost is made from all of the food scraps, yard trimmings and other organic waste you put in your green organics cart.


Trace the numbers and then write in the correct count next to each item.


Did you know....

When they are done, you've got compost!




