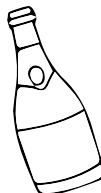
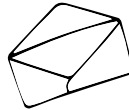
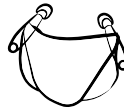


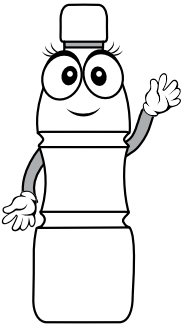
READY... RECYCLE!

Recycling is when we take a product and instead of throwing it away we use all or part of it to make another product. We can recycle most glass, paper, plastic, and metal.

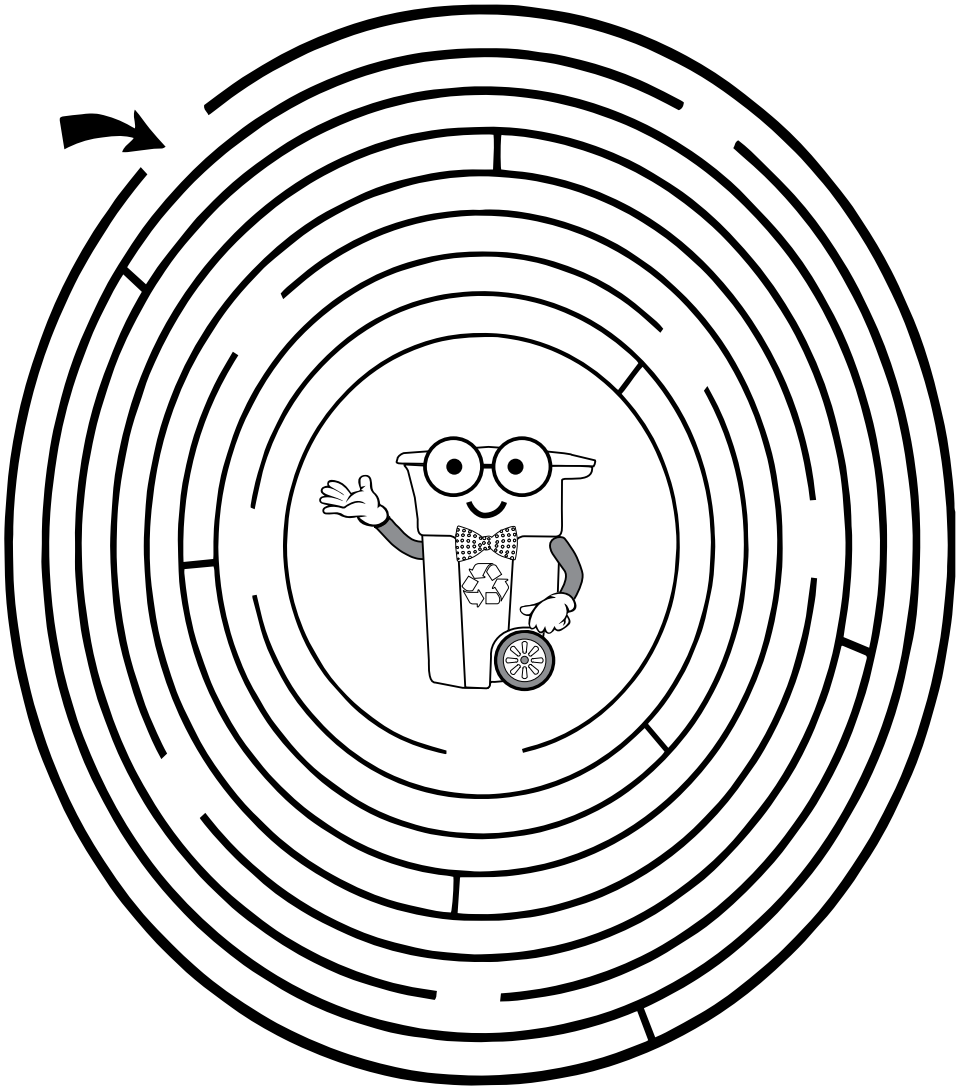
Draw a line from each item to the CART it belongs in.





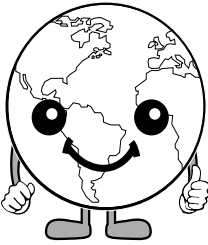

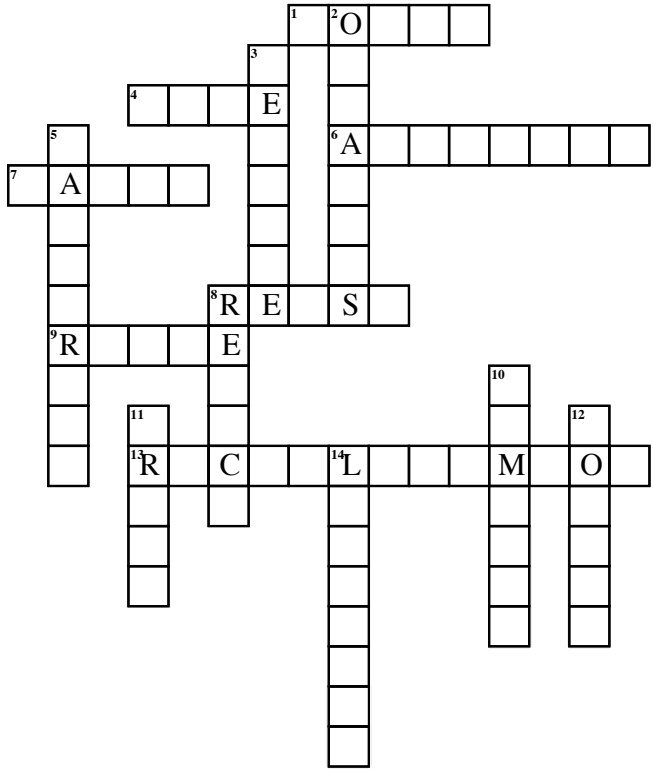

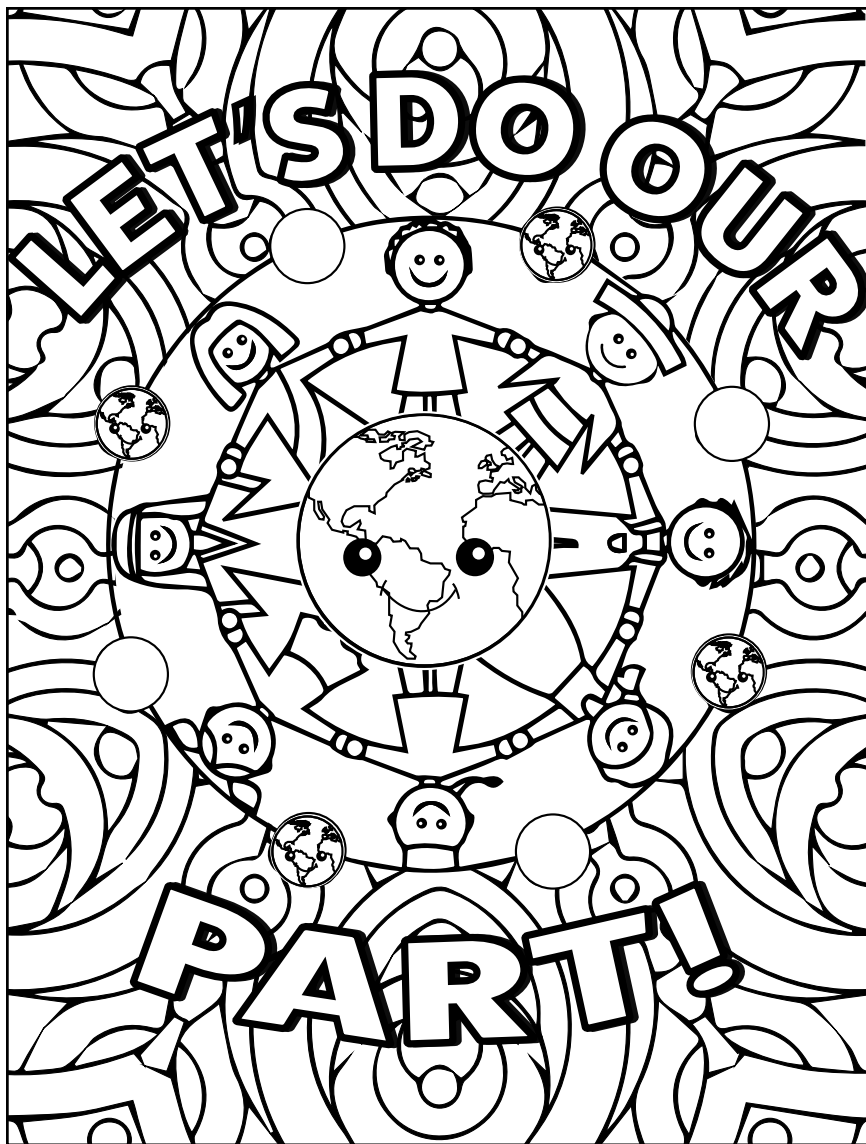
